15 Meeker oak without first obtaining the approval of the Tumwater Historic Preservation
16 Commission.
17 3. The City of Tumwater is permanently enjoined from altering or destroying the historic Davis
18 Meeker oak unless and until the City first obtains the approval of the Tumwater Historic
19 Preservation Commission.


